Feast of the Presentation of the Lord

This great feast day marks forty days after the Nativity and definitively ends the Christmas and Epiphany festivities. This ancient feast has been celebrated since at least c.386 AD, probably originating in Jerusalem. It has always been associated with the

meeting between Simeon and the infant Christ. The procession with candles highlights the journey made by the Holy Family to the temple for the purification rites required of mothers after childbirth. The blessing of the candles (added to the feast in the tenth century) and accompanying procession (during which the great Nunc Dimittis canticle is sung, proclaiming Christ as the "Light to enlighten the Gentiles") gave the name "Candlemas" to this day, which has been known by various names throughout the years: Hypapantē (Meeting), the Purification of the Blessed Virgin Mary, and (since the eighteenth century) the Presentation of the Lord.
