The 45th Annual Outdoor Way of the Cross invites people to reflect on the Gospel's relevance in today's world. This year's theme, "Walking Together in Hope," is inspired by John 3:18:

"Let us not love (only) with words or speech but with actions and in truth."

Event Details & How to Participate: The walk takes place in Edmonton's inner city and includes five stations with reflections, challenges, and sources of hope, woven together with music.

- Open to all faith traditions.
- The route is 1.5 km, suitable for most ages and abilities.
- Free street parking is available near Sacred Heart Church of the First Peoples (10821 96 Street).
- Bring non-perishable food donations for local food banks (drop-off at the start location).

A light lunch (soup, bannock, coffee, and tea) will be served at Sacred Heart Church after the final station.


