IWIN/Red Sand Project

IWIN (I'm Worth It Now), a Catholic Women's League initiative in collaboration with the Red Sand Project, is raising awareness about human trafficking-an atrocity that is occurring right here in our own province. You will notice red sand in the sidewalk cracks outside the church this weekend. This is to serve as a reminder that we cannot merely walk over the most marginalized people in our communities-those who "fall through" the metaphoric cracks.

The red sand also symbolizes the blood Christ poured out for all His children. In addition to raising awareness, IWIN provides backpacks of basic necessities to survivors of human trafficking who are entering a wrap-around program which provided education and assistance.
